Sergeant Cimino was asked what he thought the most significant changes and accomplishments were for his department. He stated that he thinks the most interesting advancements have been in the area of technology, in that with the amount of cameras and drones and high tech they can actually track crime in real time and dispense people to the scene. There was a question related to proposed legislation to limit the use of K9s, but issues were not addressed. Noted that there was proposed legislation to jump misdemeanor theft charges to a felony for three time offenders as well.
